TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Please note that Federal Airlines offer a shuttle service and not a scheduled service, therefore, times and routes may vary from day to day, depending on actual bookings. All shuttle departure times are subject to change.

1. Guests booked on shuttle flights are not guaranteed to be on the same aircraft. Federal Airlines will do all possible to assist families/groups together, subject to operational requirements.
2. Aircraft landing and/or departure may be delayed due to animals obstructing the runway.
3. O.R. Tambo International Airport is one of the busiest airports in the southern hemisphere. As such we often incur air traffic control delays due to aircraft congestion.
4. Transport between game lodge airstrips and the actual lodges will be provided by the lodge and we constantly update the lodge staff with all flight details so that they are well prepared for guest arrivals.
5. Confirmed bookings subject to automatic release if passengers' full names are not received at the time of confirmation.
6. Federal Airlines reserves the right to include technical stops en route due to operating conditions at the time, which is in the interest of safety and at the sole discretion of the captain.
7. Smoking is not permitted on flights.
8. Baggage Limitations:
 - Luggage is restricted to 20kg's (44lbs) per person in **soft baggage only** luggage/duffel bags with **one** flat side will be allowed. (all sides) with no rigid sides – size 40cm (16 inches)
Width: 30cm (12 inches) **Height:** 60cm (24 inches) **Length:**
 - One piece of hand luggage (soft piece with one flat side only) is allowed to a maximum of 5kg (11lbs).
 - Federal Air offer soft sided bags which can be purchased at Federal Air at an additional cost.
 - Oversized luggage may not be carried on your lap.
 - Excess/Additional Luggage: Due to an aircraft's constraints, excess luggage and overweight luggage is problematic Therefore, any excess luggage over 20kgs needs to be pre-booked and pre-advised. Federal Air might not always be able to assist should excess luggage not have been pre-booked.
 - For less than 10kg extra luggage, there will be an **R800** surcharge – subject to aircraft operational payload availability.
 - Should any passenger require more than 10kg extra luggage, Federal Air will allocate a "freight seat" for **R2 000**. This will allow for an additional 40kg luggage capacity. For flight safety and operational reasons, all additional freight allowances always remains subject to availability.
 - It remains the responsibility of the booking agent to inform their client of Federal Airlines' baggage policy.
 - Federal Air offer complimentary storage facilities at their lounge, based on a return flight basis only.
9. Federal Airlines operates as a point-to-point airline and will not be held responsible or liable should incoming/ connecting flights be missed/delayed resulting in passengers missing their shuttle connection to the bush or onward flights. Federal Airlines will endeavor to assist passengers on a later departure from/ to the bush subject to seat and flight availability.
10. Federal Air cannot be held liable or responsible for any delays due to weather, air traffic control or technical delays and they will rectify the situation to the best of their ability.

11. In the event of bad weather (low cloud or water-logged runways), Federal Airlines reserves the right, in the interest of safety, to either cancel the flight or divert to the nearest suitable and serviceable airstrip. This may mean a road transfer for the guests to get to/from their final destination. Upon this decision being made, either Federal Airlines or the Agent will make the necessary arrangements. This diversion will only be done in the interest of safety and when weather and/or runway conditions are not suitable to land at the original destination.
12. Federal Airlines cannot be held liable or responsible for any delays due to weather, resulting in missed connections when returning from any lodge.
13. For group bookings on shuttle flights to/from Johannesburg, bookings are restricted to 18 passengers per departure time. Any additional passengers can be accommodated on a private charter basis.
14. For group bookings on all other shuttle routes, bookings are restricted to 9 passengers per departure time.
15. Any additional passengers can be accommodated on a private charter basis.
16. Child fares are priced at 25% off the published fare, Child rates are applicable for ages 2 – 11.
17. Infant fares are priced at 75% off the published fare. Infant rates are applicable for ages 0 – 2.
18. Expectant mothers may travel with Federal Airlines up to and including the 27th week of their pregnancy. This must be inclusive of their return flight and must be able to produce a doctor's certificate confirming the stage of their pregnancy and that they are fit to fly.
19. Travel insurance is advisable.
20. Rates include VAT and are one way per person.
21. Routings and departure times may vary day to day depending on actual lodge and guest requirements as well as landing conditions.
22. Rates include use of the departure lounge for all arriving and departing guests. This includes complimentary refreshments, WiFi, shower facilities and return transport to O.R. Tambo International.

Note: The Federal Air kiosk is located at the Bus Terminus at O.R. Tambo International Airport (behind the Inter-Continental Hotel).

Valid from 1 January 2025 – 31 December 2025

15+ Days prior to departure – No charge

14 – 7 Days prior to departure – 30% of total fare

6 – Within 24 hours of departure time – 75% of total fare

Within 24 hours of departure time – 100% of total fare

AMENDMENTS TO RESERVATIONS:

Unlimited changes permitted on all bookings at no charge, up to 72 hours prior to the departure time.
